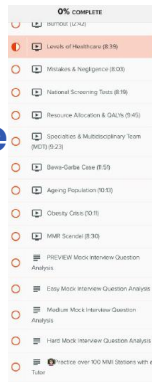

What are the levels of healthcare?



Refers to the complexity and variability of patients presenting to each stage



Primary - all the services you receive for basic, everyday health needs e.g. GPs, dentists, opticians



Secondary - services provided by health professionals who generally don't have the first contact. Usually based in a hospital or clinic



Tertiary - highly specialised treatment such as neurosurgery, transplants and secure forensic mental health services



Quaternary - Quaternary care is an extension of tertiary care that's even more specialized and highly unusual.
